ABOUT US

The Macedonian Community Language School is the largest single provider of Macedonian language in Perth, Western Australia.

The Macedonian Community Language School provides classes to multi age and ability school age children and adults with little or no background in the Macedonian language.







The main aims of the Macedonian Community Language School are to provide language and culture to all individuals irrespective of their background, religion or gender.

The Macedonian Community Language School is established on strong partnerships with students and their families and strong community involvement within the school.

The School's program delivers face to face teaching. Classes are held after hours (Weekdays/Saturday). Classes are not held during school holidays, on public holidays or on long weekends when a public holiday falls on a Saturday or a Monday.

The Macedonian Community Language School is governed by a Board that is responsible for the effective operation of the School.

CURRICULUM

The Macedonian Community Language School focuses on providing the best possible program for students.

The School works closely with teacher associations in the eastern states to develop and deliver a language course outline that is consistent with other Australian States who deliver Macedonian language.

The language course outline offers a systematic approach to teaching providing a rich and integrated program whilst retaining the traditional functions of listening, speaking, reading and writing.

Each year the language course outline is submitted to the Western Australian Department of Education under its Community Languages Program.



Cultural understandings are embedded in the language course outline, including music, songs and stories.



The Program also provides practical opportunities to use the Macedonian language in associated Community events. Students and

their families are encouraged to become involved and participate.

The Macedonian Community Language School is exploring the possibility of nationally recognised certificates in Macedonian language.

HOW TO ENROL

To enroll in Macedonian language classes all students must obtain and complete an Enrolment Form by visiting the Macedonian Community of Western Australia (Inc) website at www.macedoniawa.com.au and selecting Language Classes.

Language classes are for ages 5 to Adult.

Details on how to submit your enrolment form are listed at the bottom of the page.

School age children (up to Year 12) pay only \$150.00 and all other students pay \$350.00. Tuition fees apply to a full year. Payments received on or prior to 24 January 2014 will receive a 10% discount.

Why Learn Macedonian?

Macedonian is the official language of the Republic of Macedonia and is also spoken in neighbouring countries and around the world by people living in diaspora communities.

Many people learn Macedonian to:

- maintain the Macedonian language and culture;
- enjoy the benefits of cultural experience;
- enhance their literacy skills;
- enhance integration and communications amongst and with Macedonians across generations;
- promote future business relations in Europe;
- develop intercultural understanding and communications;
- provide students with future professional and work opportunities;
- promote understanding of multi-cultural society; and
- visit and travel in Macedonia.

How Much Does it Cost?

For 2014 the charge is:
